- III. The Grand Jury investigated the oversight and effectiveness of some County Commissions and whether some should be abolished. The report also suggested the need for a new commission and mileage reimbursement for commission members.
- IV. Key Grand Jury Recommendations where there is disagreement or need for follow up:

Recommendation 6: All commissions should receive mileage compensation.

Board of Supervisors Response: The Board of Supervisors will direct the County Administrator to provide an analysis within the next six months of the costs associated with providing mileage compensation for all commission members.
